

Supporting Documents for Course Registration

Proof of Identity

If you are underage or don't have an Australian Drivers Licence, please refer to the below suitable alternative identification. You only need to provide **ONE** of these, but if you don't have any please get in touch with Sea Safe Boat School so we can work through any support you may require.

- Australian Drivers Licence
- Australian Passport
- Proof of Age Card
- Australian Defence Force Identity Card
- Marine Certificate of Competency carrying a photo of the holder

Eye Test

If you don't have an Australian Drivers Licence you will need to complete an approved eye test. Please note that all eye tests must be completed using the correct DoT form. The Department of Transport will not accept any other form your application may be declined. Simply download the Eyesight Test/Medical Declaration form and have it completed by a medical professional such as a General Practitioner, Optometrist, or Registered Nurse.

Medical Declaration

Our assessment requirements include a Medical Declaration which is completed by yourself. If you believe you have a medical condition that could affect your ability to safely operate a skipper or boat you will require a medical examination from an authorised person. Such medical conditions include, but are not limited to:

- Epilepsy
- Heart Disease
- High or Low Blood Pressure
- Arthritis
- Type 1 Diabetes
